State of Illinois — he having received a Furlough from the 23<sup>rd</sup> day  
of December, to the third day of January 1863 at which period  
he will report to the Mustering Officer at Chicago, or be considered a deserter.

Subsistence has been furnished to said Joseph N. G. Rogers  
to the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of December and pay to the 31<sup>st</sup> day  
of October, both inclusive.
